## SUPREME COURT ACT, 1935-1964.

PURSUANT to the powers conferred by the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1964, and all other powers hereunto enabling, the majority of the Judges of the Supreme Court hereby make the following rules:-

1. In these rules The Rules of the Supreme Court, 1909, as amended Principal rules. from time to time, are referred to as the principal rules.

- 2. These rules shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1970.

- 3. Order 5, rule 5 of the principal rules is amended by deleting all 0.5 Rule 5 words after the words, "Cause Book" in line 3, and substituting the words, "and a distinguishing number shall be allocated to the action".

- 4. Order 30 of the principal rules is amended by adding after rule o. 30. Rule 1A added. 1 the following rule:-

  - 1A. Where the cause or issue has been entered for trial, a notice of the kind mentioned in rule 1 of this Order shall not be given without leave of the Court or a Judge.
