Election of Senators Act, 1903. PROCLAMATION.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, DOUGLAS KENDREW, Governor. IL.S.J By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-able Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the Election of Senators Act, 1903, it is provided that the Governor may by Proclamation to be published in the Government Gazette not less than seven days before the issue of the writ for any than seven days before the issue of the writ for any election of Senators for the State of Western Aus-tralia, fix the places at which such election shall be held, and the dates for the nomination, the polling, and the declaration of the poll and return of the writ; and whereas Friday, the 16th day of October, 1970, has been fixed as the date for the issue of a writ for the election of Senators aforesaid: New therefore L the Covernor by and with the Issue of a writ for the election of Senators aloresaid: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix Thursday, the 29th day of October, 1970, at 12 o'clock noon, as the day and time before which nominations for the said election are to be made, and Saturday, the 21st day of November, 1970, as the date for the polling at the said election, and on or before Thursday, the 7th day of January, 1971 as the date for the return of the writ: and and on or before Thursday, the 7th day of January, 1971, as the date for the return of the writ; and do hereby fix the Office of the Commonwealth Electoral Officer at Fifth Floor, The Commonwealth Centre, 1-3 St. Georges Terrace, Perth, as the place of nomination for the said election, and the polling places within the said State appointed under the law of the Commonwealth for the time being in force for the regulation of Parliamentary elections as the places at which such election shall be held. as the places at which such election shall be held.
