not exceed a circle of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter; and

- (c) smooth but not unsightly russet, where the area affected does not exceed 40% of the surface of the fruit in the case of the varieties known as Bartlett (Williams), Packham's Triumph and Comice.
- (iii) by deleting the interpretation "Domestic"; and
- (b) by substituting for the passage "Orchard", Plain or Domestic" in line two of subregulation (2) the words "Loose or Plain".

Reg. 5A add amended.

5. Regulation 5A of the principal regulations is amended by adding immediately after subregulation (2) the following sub-regulation:—

(3) For the purpose of grading and packing apples into the grade Loose the number of apples affected by slight surface blemishes shall not exceed 20% of the number of apples so graded and packed in the one container.

Reg. 6 amended. 6. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended-

- (a) by inserting after the word "and" in line two of subregulation (3) the passage", other than those graded Loose, Factory 1st Grade, or Factory 2nd Grade,";
- (b) by inserting after the paragraph designation (c) in line five of subregulation (5) the passage "except for fruit graded as Loose, Factory 1st Grade, or Factory 2nd Grade,"; and
- (c) by substituting for subregulation (7) the following subregulation—
 - (7) Subject to subregulation (2) of this regulation-
 - (a) all cases or containers of apples or pears graded as Extra Fancy, Fancy, Plain, or Cookers, shall be systematically packed; and
 - (b) all cases or containers of apples or pears graded as Loose shall not be systematically packed. .
