HEALTH ACT, 1911-1970.

Shire of Roebourne.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Health Act, 1911, as amended, a local authority may make or adopt by-laws and may alter, amend or repeal any bylaws so made or adopted: Now, therefore, the Shire of Roebourne, being a local authority within the meaning of the Act and having adopted the Model By-laws described as Series "A" as reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the Government Gazette on the 17th July, 1963, doth hereby resolve and determine that the said adopted by-laws shall be amended as follows:—

PART I.-GENERAL SANITARY PROVISIONS.

Placement of Receptacle where a Rubbish Removal Service is Provided.

14A A. The occupier of every premises in an area where a rubbish removal service is provided shall, on the day of removal of the rubbish, cause the rubbish receptacle to be placed within the premises not more than two feet distant from the usual point of access to the premises.
