WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Rear-Admiral Sir Richard John
To Wit:

WHEREAS the requirements of subsection (2) of section 25 of the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act 1972-1973 have been complied with in relation to Reserve No. 16833 which was created a reserve under the Land Act 1933-1977 and reserved for the purpose of "Use and Benefit of Aborigines": Now, therefore, I the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and pursuant to subsection (1) of section 25 of the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act 1972-1973 do hereby—

- (a) declare the land described in the Schedule to this proclamation shall cease to be reserved for persons of Aboriginal descent; and
- (b) alter the boundaries of Reserve No. 16833 created under the Land Act 1933-1977 by excising therefrom an area of land comprising of about 2.2717 hectares more particularly described in the schedule to this proclamation.

WHEREAS the requirements of subsection (2) of section 25 of the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act 1972-1973 have been complied with in relation to Reserve No. 20927 which was created a reserve under the Land Act 1933-1977 and reserved for the purpose of "Use and Benefit of Aborigines": Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and pursuant to subsection (1) of section 25 of the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act 1972-1973 do hereby—

- (a) declare the land described in the Schedule to this proclamation shall cease to be reserved for persons of Aboriganal descent; and
- (b) alter the boundaries of Reserve No. 20927 created under the Land Act 1933-1977 by excising therefrom an area of land comprising 34.68 hectares more particularly described in the schedule to this proclamation.
