Election of Senators Act 1903.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA GORDON REID, Governor. [L.S.] By His Excellency Professor Gordon Reid, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the Election of Senators Act 1903 it is provided that the Governor may, by Proclamation to be published in the Government Gazette not less than 7 days before the issue of the writ for any election of Senators for the State of Western Australia, fix the dates for the nomination, the polling, and the declaration of the poll and return of the writ; and whereas Friday, 26 October 1984, has been fixed as the date for the issue of a writ for the election of Senators aforesaid; Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix Tuesday, 6 November 1984, at 12 o'clock noon, as the day and time before which nominations for the said election are to be made, and Saturday, 1 December 1984, as the date for the polling at the said election, and on or before Thursday, 24 January 1985, as the date for the declaration of the poll and return of the writ; and do hereby fix the office of the Australian Electoral Officer at Fifth Floor, Wapet House, 12 Saint George's Terrace. Perth, as the place of nomination for the said election, and the polling places within the said State appointed under the law of the Commonwealth for the time being in force for the regulation of Parliamentary elections as the places at which such election shall be held.
