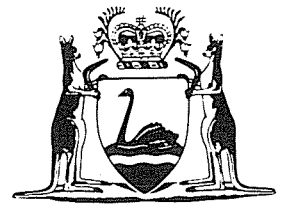

I, the Governor, acting under section 7 of the Stock Diseases (Regulations) Act 1968, and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, declare—

(a) all species of felines to be stock; and

(b) spongiform encephalopathy to be an exotic disease,

for the purposes of the Stock Diseases (Regulations) Act 1968.
