EDUCATION AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1995

Made by the Minister for Education.

Citation

These regulations may be cited as the Education Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1995.

Principal regulations

Regulation 25A inserted

After regulation 25 of the principal regulations the following regulation is inserted -

Duty statements

- Without limiting regulation 36, the chief executive officer may from time to time prepare and issue duty statements for teachers.
- A duty statement is a document providing for the duties that a teacher is to perform.
 - A duty statement
 - need not be exhaustive of all of the duties that a teacher is to perform;
 - (b) may be expressed to apply to
 - a particular teacher; or (i)
 - any group or category of teachers, either with (ii) or without exceptions;
 - may be expressed to apply at all times or at a (c) specified time or for a specified period;
