**NOTICE OF ISSUE OF WARRANT FOR LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
GENERAL ELECTION**

1. Under section 65 of the *Electoral Act 1907*, I give notice that on 14 November 1996 I received a warrant issued by His Excellency the Governor on that day under section 64 (2) of that Act directing me to issue writs for elections in all the electoral regions to elect—
  - (a) 7 members of the Legislative Council for each of the electoral regions known, respectively, as the North Metropolitan Region and the South West Region; and
  - (b) 5 members of the Legislative Council for each of the electoral regions known, respectively, as the South Metropolitan Region, the East Metropolitan Region, the Agricultural Region and the Mining and Pastoral Region.
2. Under section 64 (3) of the *Electoral Act 1907*, I caused writs for the elections to be issued on 14 November 1996.
3. The writs fix—
  - (a) 22 November 1996 as the date for the nomination of candidates;
  - (b) 14 December 1996 as the date for polling; and
  - (c) 24 January 1997 as the date for the return of the writs.
4. Under the *Electoral Act 1907*—
  - (a) the electoral rolls for the elections close at 6 p.m. on 22 November 1996; and
  - (b) nominations of candidates may be received at any time before 6 p.m. on 22 November 1996.
