ROAD TRAFFIC (VEHICLE STANDARDS) REGULATIONS 1977

Notice of exemption from the requirement to fit an immobilizer

Pursuant to regulation 1017B(2)(c) of the Road Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1977 I hereby exempt from the requirement to be fitted with an approved immobilizer any motor wagon, other than a vehicle that is, or has been previously licensed or registered under *Road Traffic Act* or any corresponding law of any State or Territory of the Commonwealth, and not being a demonstration vehicle as defined in section 5 of the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act*.

ROAD TRAFFIC (VEHICLE STANDARDS) REGULATIONS 1977

Notice of exemption from the requirement to fit an immobilizer

Pursuant to regulation 1017B(2)(c) of the Road Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1977 I hereby exempt a vehicle—

owned by the WA Police Service and used for the purpose of conveying members on urgent official duty;

owned by the WA Fire Service or a Bush Fire Brigade which is used exclusively for fire fighting or emergency rescue; or

used exclusively as an ambulance.
