NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATION OF STATE

There is a vacancy in the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia for the purpose of clause XI of the *Letters Patent relating to the Office of Governor of the State of Western Australia* dated 14 February 1986 and the Honourable David Kingsley Malcolm, AC, the Lieutenant-Governor and Chief Justice of Western Australia, is unable to act as Administrator under clauses XI and XIII of those Letters Patent.

On 11 May 2000 the Honourable Geoffrey Alexander Kennedy, AO, issued the following proclamation—

There is a vacancy in the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia for the purpose of clause XI of the *Letters Patent relating to the Office of Governor of the State of Western Australia* dated 14 February 1986 and the Honourable David Kingsley Malcolm, AC, the Lieutenant-Governor and Chief Justice of Western Australia, is unable to act as Administrator under clauses XI and XIII of those Letters Patent.

I, Geoffrey Alexander Kennedy, AO, the next most senior Judge present in the State and able to act, am authorised to be the Administrator under a dormant commission dated 4 August 1998.

I, Geoffrey Alexander Kennedy, AO, proclaim and declare that, under clauses XI and XIII of those Letters Patent, I have assumed the administration of the government of the State and, under clause XIV of those Letters Patent, may perform and exercise the powers and functions of the Governor.
