Petroleum Products Pricing Act 1983

Petroleum Products Pricing (Maximum Wholesale Price) Order 2001

Made by the Prices Commissioner under section 12 of the Act.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Petroleum Products Pricing (Maximum Wholesale Price) Order 2001*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on 12 April 2001.

3. Definitions

“cents” means cents of an Australian dollar;

“controlled motor fuel” means, while it is a declared petroleum product —

- (a) regular unleaded petrol (91 to 93 RON);
- (b) premium unleaded petrol (95 to 96 RON);
- (c) lead replacement petrol (96 RON); or
- (d) diesel fuel;

“controlled terminal” means a terminal specified in Schedule 1 or 2;

“supplier” means a person who supplies a controlled motor fuel to a reseller;

“terminal” has the same meaning as it has in Part IIIA Division 1 of the Act.
