VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING ACT 1996

C Y O'CONNOR COLLEGE OF TAFE (INTERIM GOVERNING COUNCIL) 2001

Made by the Minister for Employment and Training under section 41(3) of the *Vocational Education and Training Act 1996*.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *C Y O'Connor College of TAFE (Interim Governing Council) Order 2001*.

Commencement
