## WESTERN AUSTRALIAN PLANNING COMMISSION ACT 1985

### PEEL REGION SCHEME

APPROVED SCHEME TO BE TABLED IN PARLIAMENT

The Western Australian Planning Commission has considered all submissions received on the proposed Peel Region Scheme. The proposed Scheme was first published in the Government Gazette on 23 March 1999.

The Commission has recommended that the proposed Scheme be modified, and the proposed Scheme is further subject to environmental conditions as set by the Minister for the Environment and Heritage (and contained in Schedule 2 of the Scheme text). The proposed Peel Region Scheme (as modified) comprises the Scheme map sheets numbered 1 to 20 (1:25,000 scale) and the Scheme Text printed hereunder.

The proposed Peel Region Scheme has been presented to and approved by the Governor in accordance with the requirements of the *Western Australian Planning Commission Act* as read in conjunction with the *Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act*. The Scheme will now be tabled in both Houses of Parliament, where it must remain for 12 sitting days. During this time either House may, by resolution, disallow the proposed Scheme. As soon as the proposed Scheme is no longer subject to disallowance it has legal effect.
