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## FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

PROHIBITION ON FISHING FOR ROCK LOBSTER (GNARABUP, HAMELIN BAY AND COWARAMUP BAY) ORDER 2004

Order No. 17 of 2004

FD 1620/98 [647]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

#### Citation

1. This order may be cited as the Prohibition on Fishing for Rock Lobster (Gnarabup, Hamelin Bay and Cowaramup Bay) Order 2004.

## Interpretation

2. In this order unless the contrary intention appears—

"length" means, in relation to a boat, the length as determined in accordance with regulations made under the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982*, expressed in metres to 1 decimal point (with an amount of 0.05 metres or more being rounded upwards to the next 0.1 of a metre).

## Prohibition on fishing

3. A person must not fish for rock lobster in any of the waters described in the Schedule with the use of a boat greater than 8 metres in length.

#### Schedule

# Waters to which this order applies

## 1. Gnarabup

All waters off the west coast of Western Australia bounded by the line commencing at the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and  $34^{\circ}$  00.250′ south latitude; thence extending west along the parallel to the intersection of  $34^{\circ}$  00.250′ south latitude and  $114^{\circ}$  59.127′ east longitude; thence north north west along the meridian to the intersection of  $33^{\circ}$  58.100′ south latitude and  $114^{\circ}$  58.575′ east longitude; thence east along the parallel to the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and  $33^{\circ}$  58.100′ south latitude; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the coastline to the commencement point.

### 2. Hamelin Bay

All waters off the west coast of Western Australia bounded by the line commencing at the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and 34° 13.443′ south latitude; thence extending westerly along the geodesic to the intersection of 34° 13.495′ south latitude and 115° 00.900′ east longitude; thence north north west along the geodesic to the intersection of 34° 13.215′ south latitude and 115° 00.790′ east longitude; thence north east by east along the geodesic to the intersection of 34° 12.953′ south latitude and 115° 01.210′ east longitude; thence south east by east along the geodesic to the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and 34° 13.234′ south latitude; thence generally south westerly and south easterly along the high water mark to the commencement point.

## 3. Cowaramup Bay

All waters off the west coast of Western Australia bounded by the line commencing at the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and  $114^{\circ}$  58.550′ east longitude; thence extending north west by north along the geodesic to the intersection of 33° 51.700′ south latitude and  $114^{\circ}$  58.440′ east longitude; thence north east by east along the geodesic to the intersection of 33° 51.350′ south latitude and  $114^{\circ}$  59.000′ east longitude; thence south east by south along the geodesic to the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and 33° 51.440′ south latitude; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the coastline to the commencement point.
