PROHIBITION ON FISHING (SHANNON RIVER) ORDER 2007
Order No. 2 of 2007

Made by the Minister under section 43.

1. Citation

This order is the *Prohibition on Fishing (Shannon River) Order 2007*.

2. Interpretation

In this order—

“Shannon River” means all waters of the Shannon River, including all its tributaries and the Shannon Dam, upstream of the intersection of the Shannon River and the natural prolongation of Springbreak Road (34° 52.333' south latitude).

3. Prohibition on fishing

A person must not fish by any means in the Shannon River.
