**EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1993**

**AUTHORISATION OF OFFICERS**

For the purposes of the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1993* in relation to the whole of the State of Western Australia those persons who are employed or engaged by the Department of Agriculture and Food Western Australia as Biosecurity Officers and Quarantine Inspectors are appointed to be officers for the purpose of the exercise by those persons of the powers of an officer under the Act.

**EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1993**

**IMPORT RESTRICTION ORDER NO. 02/2007**

Made by the Minister of Agriculture and Food under section 24 of the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1993*.

Import Restriction order 02/2007 replaces Import restriction Order 01/2007.

Equine Influenza has been confirmed in the states of New South Wales and Queensland.

Except as by a permit issued by the Chief Veterinary Officer, the restrictions set out in the table below apply to movement to Western Australia from other parts of the Commonwealth.

Item restricted*	Place of origin**	Restriction***
Horses, donkeys and mules.	All states and territories.	Prohibited
Equine products.	All states and territories.	Prohibited
Fresh equine semen	All states and territories.	Prohibited
Horse equipment meaning tack, bridles brushes buckets and other articles that have come in contact with equines.	All states and territories.	Prohibited unless under permit.

This order applies until 30 September 2007.
