## **PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2005**

## **GREATER BUNBURY REGION SCHEME**

APPROVED SCHEME TO BE TABLED IN PARLIAMENT

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) has considered all the submissions received in respect of the proposed Greater Bunbury Region Scheme. Notification of the scheme was first published in the *Government Gazette* on 8 September 2000. The proposed Greater Bunbury Region Scheme includes the Scheme map sheets numbered 1 to 23 (1:25,000 scale).

The scheme, with modifications, has been presented to and approved by the Governor in accordance with the requirements of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*. It will now be laid before each House of Parliament. Either House may, within 12 sitting days after the Scheme is laid before it, by resolution, disallow the scheme. As soon as the scheme is no longer subject to disallowance it becomes legally effective.
