CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1971

INTERIM PROHIBITING ORDER

Section 23Q

- I, Patrick John Walker Commissioner for Consumer Protection in the State of Western Australia-
 - 1. having referred to the Consumer Product Safety Committee the question of whether, in the interests of the safety of the public the supply of goods of the class described in the Schedule ought, by reason of the goods being dangerous, or the supply of the goods being dangerous, to be prohibited or allowed only subject to restrictions or conditions; and
 - 2. believing on reasonable grounds that the said goods are so dangerous that their supply ought, in the interests of the safety of the public be prohibited immediately,

hereby prohibit for a period of 28 days from the date of publication of this order in the *Gazette* the supply of the class of goods described in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

"Bindeez" bead toys which are little beads that join with a spray of water.
