## LAND ADMINISTRATION ACT 1997

INSTRUMENT OF SUB-DELEGATION

I, Simon McDonnell O'Brien, MLC, Minister for Transport, Minister responsible for administering the Main Roads Act 1930, acting in accordance with section 160(1)(b) of the Land Administration Act, hereby sub-delegate to the Executive Director Finance and Commercial Services, Main Roads Western Australia, the powers and duties under those sections of the Land Administration Act listed in the following schedule—

255	Easements may be granted in lieu of compensation or purchase money
257	Minister may grant surplus land in lieu of compensation
