**PEARLING ACT 1990**

**CANCELLATION OF PEARL OYSTER FARM LEASES AND THE  
GRANT OF PEARL OYSTER FARM LEASES**

FD 319/06, 997/98, 787/00, 840/01, 1084/01, 317/06, 396/06, 629/07, 27/00, 1046/98, 1085/01

I, Greg Paust, Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Fisheries, Western Australia, pursuant to Section 23 and Section 30 of the Pearling Act 1990 ("the Pearling Act") have granted applications submitted by—

- Pearls Pty Ltd,
- The Australian South Sea Pearling Company Pty Ltd,
- Paspaley Pearling Company Pty Ltd, Roebuck Pearl Producers Pty Ltd, Pearls Pty Ltd and the Australian South Sea Pearling Company Pty Ltd; and
- The Paspaley Pearling Company Pty Ltd

1. To cancel pearl oyster farm leases in respect of areas of water located at—

- Port Nelson
- Gale Island
- Osborne Islands D

2. To cancel existing leases and conditionally issue new pearl oyster farm leases (which are located entirely within the boundaries of the previous leases) in respect of areas of water located at—

- Prince Frederick Harbour
- Prince Frederick Harbour—Boongaree Island
- Parry Harbour
- Vansittart Bay
- Seaflower Bay
- Seaflower Bay B.
- Katja Island
- Anderdon Islands—Area 1
- Anderdon Islands—Area 2
- Osborne Islands South West
- Osborne Islands A
- Osborne Islands B
- Encounter Cove

3. The issue of each of the new pearl oyster farm leases named in part 2 of this Notice only takes effect upon the cancellation of the existing lease at the site. The new lease will expire on the date on which an application to review the decision to cancel the lease is accepted by the SAT.

Under section 33(1) of the Pearling Act a person aggrieved by my decision may apply to the State Administrative Tribunal (SAT) for a review of the decision. Application forms can be obtained from the SAT located at Level 4, 12 St Georges Terrace, Perth WA or from the SAT's website at [www.sat.justice.wa.gov.au](http://www.sat.justice.wa.gov.au). The application together with any supporting documents should be lodged with the SAT within 28 days of publication of the Notice. When an application

is accepted by the Chief Executive Officer of the SAT, the applicant is to give a copy of the application to the Chief Executive Officer, Department of Fisheries, Level 3, 168 St Georges Terrace, Perth WA.
