James Point, Kwinana—Port Facility

Outcome of Submissions

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) has considered all the submissions received in respect of the amendment proposal for the James Point, Kwinana—Port Facility Amendment 1035/33. This proposal was first published in the *Government Gazette* on 29 March 2005. The amendment is shown on WAPC plan number 3.1456/1.

The amendment, as advertised, has been presented to and approved by the Governor in accordance with the requirements of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*. It will now be tabled in both Houses of Parliament, where it must remain for 12 sitting days. During this time either House may, by resolution, disallow the amendment.
