## **CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT ACT 1899**

## RECONSTITUTION OF THE MINISTRY

It is notified for public information that the Governor, acting on the advice of the Premier, has received and accepted the resignation of the Honourable Peter Charles Collier MLC, Minister for Energy; Training, with effect on and from 17 November 2009.
