AGRICULTURE AND RELATED RESOURCES PROTECTION ACT 1976

DECLARATION

The Agriculture Protection Board hereby revokes all previous declarations made under sections 35 and 36 of the *Agriculture and Related Resources Protection Act 1976* and pursuant to those provisions declares that—

1. The plants and animals listed below (other than those stated to be excluded from the declaration) are declared plants and animals and are assigned to the categories indicated in the lists in relation to those plants and animals;
2. A declared plant or animal listed below (unless it is stated to be excluded from the declaration) is either a declared plant or animal in the whole of the State and every part of the State or a declared plant or animal only in respect of the part or parts of the State specified in the lists in relation to that plant or animal, as applicable;
3. A declared plant or animal listed below (unless it is stated to be excluded from the declaration) is declared generally or only in the particular circumstances specified in the lists in relation to that plant or animal, as applicable;
4. All vertebrate animals other than fish that are not listed below and are not indigenous to the State and all hybrids of those animals are declared animals in respect of the whole of the State and every part of the State, generally, and are assigned to the categories A1, A2, A3;
5. The European House Borer (*Hylotrupes bajulus*)—
 - (a) is a declared animal in respect of the whole of the State and every part of the State
 - (b) is declared generally;
 - (c) is assigned to categories A2 and A3 in the areas described below, each of which is designated as a Restricted Movement Zone (RMZ); and
 - (d) is assigned to categories A1 and A3 in the rest of the State.

DECLARED PLANTS

NOTE—

- The following summarises the effect of the declaration categories for plants under the *Agriculture and Related Resources Protection Act 1976*—
 - o P1—Introduction of the plant into, or movement of the plant within, an area is prohibited;
 - o P2—Plant to be eradicated in the area.
 - o P3—Plant to be controlled by reduction in number or distribution of the plant or both.
 - o P4—Spread of plant beyond where it currently occurs to be prevented.
 - o P5—Particular action to be taken on public land or land under the control of a local government.
- Information about requirements relating to the introduction, movement, eradication and control of declared plants is available from the Department of Agriculture and Food.

DECLARED PLANTS—LIST

Aquarium Plants (plants of any class used or grown in aquariums unless they are plants that are on premises for the time being accredited by the Chief Agriculture Protection Officer as premises free from any snails capable of acting as intermediate hosts for the fluke *Fasciola hepatica*, or are in the course of being moved from such premises): P1; for the whole of the State.
