METROPOLITAN REGION SCHEME MINOR AMENDMENT 1193/57

South East and South West Districts Omnibus

Call for Public Submissions

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) intends to amend the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) for land in the local governments of Armadale, Canning, Cockburn, Fremantle, Gosnells, Rockingham, Victoria Park, Serpentine-Jarrahdale and Kalamunda and is seeking public comment.

The purpose of the amendment is to update various zones and reservations in the South East and South West Districts of the Perth Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) in relation to Government and landowner proposals, rationalisations of zones and reservations to match cadastral boundaries and generally to ensure the MRS is kept up-to-date as the statutory regional plan for Perth.

The Western Australian Planning Commission certifies that, in its opinion, the proposed amendment does not constitute a substantial alteration to the MRS.

The plans showing the proposed change and the WAPC amendment report which explains the proposals will be available for public inspection from Tuesday 17 August 2010 to Friday 22 October 2010 at—
