## WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MARINE ACT 1982 NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS 1958

Shire of Augusta Margaret River
PROHIBITED SWIMMING AREA
Augusta River

Department of Transport, Fremantle WA, 4 March 2011.

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 10A (b) of the *Navigable Waters Regulations* 1958, I hereby close all of the following waters to swimming, between 8:00pm and 9:00pm on Sunday 6th March 2011.

AUGUSTA RIVER: All the waters within a 200 metre radius around the firing point; located on the Augusta River Mouth at approximately 34° 19′26.44″S 115° 10′18.57″E.

This area is set aside for safety measures during the set up and display of pyrotechnics.
