Hospitals (Services Charges for Specialized Orthoses and Prostheses) Determination 1994

1. Citation

This determination may be cited as the *Hospitals (Services Charges for Specialized Orthoses and Prostheses)* Determination 1994.

2. Commencement

This determination comes into operation on 1 November 1994.

3. Interpretation

- (1) Subject to this clause a word or phrase to which a meaning is attributed by, or by virtue of its use in the *Hospitals (Services Charges) Regulations 1984* has the same meaning when it is used in this determination.
- (2) In this determination, unless the contrary intention appears
 - *at cost*, in relation to the charge for each specialized orthosis or prosthesis, means the charge calculated by the hospital in accordance with the pricing policy of the hospital;
 - *pricing policy*, means the pricing policy approved by the Board of the hospital as the basis on which charges are to be calculated for the supply of specialized orthoses or prostheses by the hospital and specifying the component costs that may be recovered by the hospital in respect of

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	la	such supplies which components may include the cost of labour, material and general overheads but does include any component for profit;			
	- sj	<i>alized orthoses and prostheses</i> means the classes of pecialized orthoses and prostheses approved by the Board or supply at cost for the hospital.
