Part 1 — Introduction

Division 1—**Preliminary matters**

1. Short title

This is the Cross-border Justice Act 2008.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows:

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act on a day fixed by proclamation, and different days may be fixed for different provisions.
