W.A. Marine (Emergency Procedures and Safety of Navigation) Regulations 1983

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the W.A. Marine (Emergency Procedures and Safety of Navigation) Regulations 1983 ¹.

2. Commencement

These regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1984.

3. Interpretation Terms used

- (1) In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears

 Authority means the chief executive officer; and
 - *Code* means the Uniform Shipping Laws Code incorporating the amendments adopted by the Australian Transport Council on 1 October 2007;
- NSCV means the National Standard for Commercial Vessels described in the Code.
- Note: The definition of *Code* refers to the Code as amended by Amendment Lists 5 and 6 adopted by the Australian Transport Council on 1 October 2007 and available at http://www.nmsc.gov.au/uslcode_2.html. That version of the Code contains provisions that affect the operation of regulations that refer to it, and should be, referred to when interpreting those regulations in section 115 of the Act, as in existence on 1 October 2009.

(2) In the provisions of the Code incorporated in these regulations, a term has the same meaning as it has in the Code.

4. Application

These regulations apply to all vessels to which the Act applies.

5. Application Incorporation of Section 15 of Code

- (1) Subject to subregulation (2), the The provisions of Section 15 of the Code-, modified as set out in subregulation (2), are incorporated in these regulations and shall extend and apply to and in respect of all vessels and voyages to which the Act applies.
- (2) The incorporation and application of For the purposes of subregulation (1) Section 15 of the Code by subregulation (1) is subject to the following modifications
- (a) clauses 4.1, 5.1, 7.2, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8, 8.1, 8.3, 9.1 and 9.3 shall not apply to vessels of Classes 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D and 3E not exceeding 25 metres in length where the number of persons on board, excluding passengers, does not exceed 4;
 - (b) for clause 10.1 there shall be substituted the following
- " 10.1 The master of modified as follows a
 Class 1B vessel having a length in excess of 45
 metres shall
 - (a) drill those members of the crew assigned for special duties in connection with the assembly and use of rocket line throwing apparatus at such times as he thinks fit; and
 - (b) hold practices with the apparatus within

7. Offences

The master of a vessel or any other person who without reasonable excuse contravenes or otherwise fails to comply with a requirement of these regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of \$1 000.

[8. Construction of Code

In the construction of the Code as incorporated in these regulations, words and expressions defined in the NSCV, Part B, Clause 1.8 shall, unless otherwise provided by the Act or these regulations, have the meanings assigned in that clause.

9. Classification of vessels

For the purposes of these regulations, vessels shall be classified in the manner provided by clause 6 of Section 1 of the Code.
