W.A. Marine (Life Saving Appliances, Fire Appliances and Miscellaneous Equipment) Regulations 1983

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the W.A. Marine (Life Saving Appliances, Fire Appliances and Miscellaneous Equipment) Regulations 1983 ¹.

2. Commencement

These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1983.

3. Interpretation Terms used

(1) In these regulations—unless the context otherwise requires—

Authority means the chief executive officer;

Code means the Uniform Shipping Laws Code incorporating the amendments adopted by the Australian Transport Council on 1 October 2007;

NSCV means the National Standard for Commercial Vessels described in the Code.

Note: The definition of *Code* refers to the Code as amended by Amendment Lists 5 and 6 adopted by the Australian Transport Council on 1 October 2007 and available at http://www.nmsc.gov.au/uslcode_2.html. That version of the Code contains provisions that affect the operation of regulations

that refer to it, and should be, referred to when interpreting those regulations in section 115 of the Act, as in existence on 1 October 2009.

(2) In the construction provisions of the Code as-incorporated in these regulations, words and expressions defined in the NSCV, Part B, Clause 1.8 shall, unless otherwise provided by the Act or these regulations, have the meanings assigned a term has the same meaning as it has in that clause the Code.

- 4. Application Incorporation of Sections-10, and 11, and 13 of Code
 - (1) Subject to subregulation (3), the The provisions of Sections Section 10, and 11, and 13 of the Code are incorporated in these regulations and shall extend and apply to and in respect of all vessels and voyages to which the Act applies.

5. Incorporation of Section 13 of the Code

(1) In this regulation —

List 7 vessel means a new vessel as defined in clause 2 of Amendment List 7 to the Code by as adopted on 7 November 2008.

(2) The provisions of Section 13 of the Code that apply to vessels that are not List 7 vessels, modified as set out in subregulation (1)3), are incorporated in these regulations and extend and apply to and in respect of all such vessels and voyages to which the Act applies.

For the purposes of subregulation (2) Section 13 of the Code is subject to the following modifications — modified as follows —

- (f) Item 6 of delete Part I of 4 Appendix B to Part 4 shall be deleted 1 item 6;
- (g) Item b) delete Part 4 of Appendix M to Part 4 shall be deleted; and item 4;

- The provisions of Section 13 of the Code that apply to List 7 (4) vessels, modified as set out in subregulation (5), are incorporated in these regulations and extend and apply to and in respect of all List 7 vessels and voyages to which the Act applies.
- For the purposes of subregulation (4) Section 13 of the Code is modified as follows -
 - (a) a reference in Section 13 of the Code to Part C Section 7C of the National Standard for Commercial Vessels does not include a reference to Part C Section 7C Annex A clause A4 of that Standard;
 - a reference in Section 13 of the Code to Part E of the National Standard for Commercial Vessels does not include a reference to Part E item 2.11.1.3 of that Standard.

6. Classification of vessels

For the purposes of these regulations, vessels shall be classified in the manner provided by the NSCV, Part B, Chapter 3, as incorporated into clause 6 of Section 1 of the Code.
