Sunday Entertainments Regulations 2006

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Sunday Entertainments* Regulations 2006.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the later of —

- the day on which they are published in the Gazette; and
- the day on which the Criminal Procedure Amendment (b) Regulations (No. 2) 2006 come into operation.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations —

Commissioner has the same meaning as it has in the *Consumer* Affairs Fair Trading Act 1971 2010.

4. Prescribed offences and modified penalties

The offences specified in Schedule 1 are offences for which an (1) infringement notice may be issued under the Criminal Procedure Act 2004 Part 2.

(2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in Schedule 1 is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of the Criminal Procedure Act 2004 section 5(3).

5. Authorised officers and approved officers

- The Commissioner may, in writing, appoint persons or classes (1) of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of the Criminal Procedure Act 2004 Part 2.
- The Commissioner is to issue to each authorised officer a (2) certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.

6. Forms

The forms set out in Schedule 2 are prescribed in relation to the matters specified in those forms.
