1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications* (*Interception_and Access*) Western Australia Regulations 1996¹.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Telecommunications (Interception) Western Australia* Act 1996³/₋ comes into operation ¹-.

4. Parliamentary Commissioner and officers of the Commissioner prescribed as inspecting officers

- (1) The Parliamentary Commissioner is an inspecting officer for the purposes of the Act.
- (2) Each officer of the Commissioner is an inspecting officer for the purposes of the Act.

5. Parliamentary Commissioner prescribed as principal inspector

The Parliamentary Commissioner is the principal inspector for the purposes of the Act.
