# Water Boards (Bunbury) Regulations 1997

#### 1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Water Boards (Bunbury) Regulations 1997* <sup>1</sup>.

## 2. Definition

In these regulations —

**Bunbury Water Board** means the Water Board for the Water Area that was constituted as the Bunbury Water Area by Order in Council published in the *Gazette* on 5 January 1906.

## 3. Membership of Bunbury Water Board

- (1) The Bunbury Water Board, as constituted by the appointment of the members by the Governor under the *Water Boards (Bunbury Water Board Constitution) Order 1997*, is to consist of 6 members.
- (2) Each member is to hold office for such period, not exceeding 3 years, as is fixed by the member's instrument of appointment, being a period fixed so that 2 members go out of office by effluxion of time every year.
