Rates and Charges (Rebates and Deferments) Regulations 1992

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Rates and Charges (Rebates and Deferments) Regulations 1992*¹.

3. Maximum limit for rebate

The limit on the amount of rebate that an eligible senior is to be allowed for a type of prescribed charge referred to in section 40(9)(a) and (c) of the Act is the amount set in the following Table for a charge of that type for the rating year during which the service to which the charge relates was provided.

- (1) The limit on the amount of rebate that an eligible pensioner is to be allowed for a type of prescribed charge referred to in section 40(9)(b) of the Act is the amount set in the following Table for a charge of that type for the rating year during which the service to which the charge relates was provided.

- (2) For the rating year of 2016 - 2017, a limit is not placed on the amount of rebate that a pensioner is to be allowed on the following prescribed charges —
- (a) a charge, by way of a rate, made under the *Soil and Land Conservation Act 1945*; or
 - (b) a charge by way of the emergency services levy; or
 - (c) a charge, by way of a service charge, made under the *Local Government Act 1995* section 6.38 in relation to the provision of underground electricity.
