1. Citation

These regulations are the *Western Australian Health Promotion Foundation Regulations 2016*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day on which the *Western Australian Health Promotion Foundation Act 2016* Part 6 comes into operation.
