Electoral (Ballot Paper Forms) Regulations 1990

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Electoral (Ballot Paper Forms) Regulations 1990*¹.

2. Form of ballot papers

- (1) Ballot papers for elections shall be in the appropriate form set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) The forms in Schedule 1 replace the forms set out in Schedule 3 to the Act.






