## Fair Trading (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006

## 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Fair Trading (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006.* 

## 2. Prescribed offences and modified penalties

- (1) The offences specified in Schedule 1 are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under section 73 of the Act.
- (2) The modified penalty to be specified in an infringement notice issued for an offence is the modified penalty set out for that offence in Schedule 1.

### 3. Forms

The forms set out in Schedule 2 are prescribed in relation to the matters specified in those forms.
