Government Employees' Housing Regulations 1965

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Government Employees'* Housing Authority Regulations 1965¹.

2. Interpretation

In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears —

"chairperson" means the person appointed as chairman of the Authority under section 8(2)(a) of the Act;


"metropolitan region" has the same meaning as is from time to time ascribed to it by the *Town Planning and Development Act 1928*;

"secretary" means the person for the time being holding the office of Director of the Authority and includes the Deputy Director.

"the Act" means the *Government Employees' Housing Act 1964.*

6. Form of warrant
