## Government Railways By-laws — By-law 86 (Aiding and Abetting Offenders, etc.)

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor in Council has been pleased to approve of the following By law, which shall have effect from the 21st day of September, 1937:—

### 86. Aiding and Abetting Offenders, etc.

Any person who counsels or procures another or aids or abets another in committing a breach of any of these By-laws commits an offence and shall be liable to the same penalty as if he himself had committed a breach of the By-law.
