Offensive Trades (Fees) Regulations 1976

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Offensive Trades (Fees)* Regulations 1976¹.

2. **Application**

These regulations have effect in every local government ² district within the State.

3. Prescribed fees

The fees set out in the Table to this regulation are payable on the registration of —

- the offensive trades specified in Schedule 2 of the Act;
- (b) any process or class of trade declared to be an offensive trade under section 186 of the Act.
