Health (Offensive Trades Fees) Regulations 1976

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Health (Offensive Trades Fees) Regulations 1976*.

2. Application

These regulations have effect in every local government² district within the State.

3. Prescribed fees

The fees set out in the Table to this regulation are payable on the registration of —

- (a) the offensive trades specified in Schedule 2 of the Act;
or
- (b) any process or class of trade declared to be an offensive trade under section 186 of the Act.
