HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1960*, has been pleased to cause the draft model by-law set out in the schedule hereto to be prepared and published.

1. Citation

This by-law may be cited as the *Local Government By-law* (Deposit of Refuse and Litter) No. 16.

2. Littering

A person shall not —

- (a) break any glass, metal, earthenware or utensil; or
- (b) deposit or leave, except in a receptacle provided for that purpose, refuse or litter, of any kind,

or cause any of those things to be done, in any street, public place or public reserve, vested in or under the control of the Council, or on any property of the Council.
