Notification of Disease Regulations

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Notification of Disease Regulations*¹.

2. Revocation

The *Notification of Infections Disease Regulations* published in the *Government Gazette* on 19 May 1922, are revoked.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations —

“**Act**” means the *Health Act 1911*.

Expressions used in these regulations have the same respective meanings as in the Act.

5. Notice fee prescribed (section 276)

A fee of \$2 is payable by the Minister to a medical practitioner in respect of each notice received by the Executive Director, Public Health under section 276(1)(c) except that no fee shall be

payable where a medical practitioner is a salaried employee of a government or public institution.
