Police (Fees) Regulations 1981

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Police (Fees) Regulations 1981*¹.

2. Fees

- (1) A fee specified in the Schedule to these regulations is the fee payable for the purpose set out opposite the fee in that Schedule.
- (2) The Commissioner of Police may reduce, waive or refund, in whole or in part, any moneys due under this regulation.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations —

“**accident**” has the same meaning as in Part V of the *Road Traffic Act 1974*;

“**department**” means the department of the Public Service principally assisting the Minister in the administration of the Act;

“**road traffic conviction record**”, in respect of a person, means the record held in the department of the person’s convictions against the *Road Traffic Act 1974*;

“**traffic infringement notice record**”, in respect of a person, means the record held in the department of infringement
