1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Health Act (Carbon Monoxide) Regulations 1975*⁴.

2. Prescribed concentration of carbon monoxide

The concentration of carbon monoxide prescribed for the purposes of section 182(13) of the Act is 50 parts per million measured over one hour.
