Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act (Search Warrant) Regulations 1979

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act (Search Warrant) Regulations 1979*¹.

2. Form of Warrant

For the purposes of section 53 of the *Explosives and Dangerous Goods Act 1961*, a search warrant shall be in the following form —

This is therefore to authorise and request you together with
a police constable at any time or times within 14 days
from the date of this warrant to enter, if need be by force,
