RURAL AND INDUSTRIES BANK.

No. 4 of 1968.

AN ACT to amend the Rural and Industries Bank Act. 1944-1966.

[Assented to 26th September, 1968.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Rural and Short title and citation. Industries Bank Act Amendment Act, 1968.

- (2) In this Act the Rural and Industries Bank Reprinted Acts Vol. 14 Act, 1944-1966, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Rural and Industries Bank Act, 1944-1968.

Amendment to s. 19 (Powers and Authorities).

- 2. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section nineteen of the principal Act is repealed and re-enacted as follows—
 - (d) enter into contracts in respect of which tenders have been invited from the public, for the building of dwelling houses on acquired land;
- Amendment to s. 96 (Accounts).
- 3. Section ninety-six of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by repealing paragraph (c) of subsection (1); and
 - (b) by deleting the words, "and analysed cash account" in lines one and two of subsection (2).
- Amendment to s. 98 (Report to be made annually to Parliament).
- 4. Subsection (1) of section ninety-eight of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word, "accounts" in line eight, the word, "account".
