KWINANA-MUNDIJONG-JARRAHDALE RAILWAY EXTENSION.

No. 62 of 1967.

AN ACT to authorise the construction of a railway to extend the Kwinana-Mundijong-Jarrahdale Railway.

[Assented to 5th December, 1967.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Kwinana-Mundijong-Jarrahdale Railway Extension Act, 1967.

Authority to construct railway Cf. S. 96 of No. 47 of 1902. 2. It shall be lawful to construct and maintain a railway with all necessary, proper and usual works and conveniences in connection therewith as an extension of the Kwinana-Mundijong-Jarrahdale

Kwinana-Mundijong- [No. 62. Jarrahdale Railway Extension.

Railway constructed under the authority of the Kwinana-Mundijong-Jarrahdale Railway Act, 1961, between the points and along the line described in the Schedule to this Act, and more particularly defined and delineated and coloured red on the plan marked C.E. Plan No. 59484 deposited pursuant to section ninety-six of the Public Works Act, 1902.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Authority Public Works Act, 1902, it shall be lawful to deviate deviation. from the line as described in the Schedule to this Act, to the extent of five miles on either side of that line.

SCHEDULE.

Kwinana-Mundijong-Jarrahdale Railway Extension. Description of line of Railway.

Commencing at a point at the end of the Mundijong to Jarrahdale Railway 36 miles 55 chains from Perth and proceeding thence in an Easterly direction for about 54 chains thence in a North Easterly direction for about 16 chains thence in a Northerly direction for 30 chains thence in a North Easterly direction for about 54 chains thence in a North Easterly direction for about 54 chains thence in a Northerly direction for about 48 chains thence in a North Easterly direction for about 17 chains thence in an Easterly direction for about 53 chains thence in a North Easterly direction for a distance of 39 chains terminating at a mileage of 40 miles 30 chains from Perth and more particularly as set out and delineated in red on map marked C.E. Plan No. 59484 deposited pursuant to the Public Works Act, 1902, section 96.

Total length three miles 55 chains.
