AN ACT to amend clause eleven of the First Schedule to the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1966.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

2. Clause eleven of the First Schedule to the Act Schedule is amended by substituting for the word, "seven" in line four of paragraph (i), the word, "ten".

3. This Act is deemed to have had effect, for all Retroactivity. purposes, from and including the fifth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
