AN ACT to amend the Stock Diseases Act, 1895-1960.

[Assented to 27th October, 1966.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Stock Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1966.

- (2) In this Act the Stock Diseases Act, 1895-1960, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Stock Diseases Act, 1895-1966.

- 2. Section four of the principal Act is amended smended. by adding after the interpretation, "Owner.", the following interpretation—

 - "Poultry."—Any poultry, poultry products, the carcase or any portion of the carcase of any poultry, newly hatched chickens, or the eggs of any poultry for hatching purposes or for food purposes: .
- 3. Section five of the principal Act is amended s.5 amended by substituting for the words, "five hundred pounds" in the last two lines of subsection (3), the words, "one thousand dollars".

- 4. Section six of the principal Act is amended— s.6 amended.
 - (a) by substituting for the words, "one hundred pounds" in lines one and two of paragraph (9c) of subsection (1), the words, "two hundred dollars"; and
 - (b) by substituting for the words, "Five hundred pounds" in the last line of subsection (2), the words, "One thousand dollars".
- 5. Section eighteen of the principal Act is s.18 amended by substituting for the words, "One hundred pounds" in the last two lines, the words, "Two hundred dollars".
- 6. Section twenty of the principal Act is amended s. 20 amended. by substituting for the words, "Two hundred pounds" in lines thirty-one and thirty-two, the words, "Four hundred dollars".
